# Internet Access to Valacta Data

## Description of services

Valacta data on any dairy producer can be accessed by third parties (service providers, professionals, industry advisors) **with the written consent of the producer** (complete form F-49 on reverse).

The authorized person will be issued a *contact number* and a *personal identification number (PIN)* distinct from that of the producer. This identification allows the industry advisor to access the data of all producers who grant written consent with form F-49. A producer may grant access to several advisors.

Available data include all vital statistics on every animal, notably milk production, milk analysis results (fat, protein, somatic cell count), optional analyses (milk urea nitrogen), forage analyses, as well as the averages, graphs and benchmarks appearing on the *Vision2000* Reports.

Data can be accessed via the Internet on average between 48 and 72 hours after the test date.

Data can be downloaded from the Valacta Web site by following the link *on-line data access*. TIP and XML files can also be sent directly to the user by E-mail (check the corresponding box on form F-49.).

According to the user's need, **four file formats are available:**

### **TIP**

TIP files (*Transfer of Information from Valacta*) allow the integration of 70 different data on each cow directly into your management software. Available 3 days after the test.

### **XML**

XML-TIP files allow the integration of data in the *Agri-Lacta* software.

### **XML-VET**

XML-VET files allow the integration of data in veterinarians' *DS@HR* software.

### **DairyComp 305**

These files allow the integration of data in the *DairyComp 305* software.

### **Vision2000 Reports (PDF)**

Reports can be downloaded as a compressed PDF file for direct on-screen viewing or printing. Usually on-line 2 days after the test date.

## **Files available for three months**

The user is invited to save the files on his/her own computer as soon as they become available. The files will remain accessible on the Valacta Web site for a maximum of three months after test day (92 days).

## **Cost**

Depending on the box checked above the producer's signature, either the industry advisor (the person or the company) or the producer will be billed (per test) according to the current price list.
